## Military Ballot Application for May 21, 2024 Election

Under Education Law Sec. 2018-d

A completed application must be received by the District Clerk at least seven (7) days before the election if the ballot is to be mailed to the voter, or the day before the election if the ballot is to be delivered personally to the voter. The Military Voter may choose the method of delivery of the application and the ballot to him/her. However, regardless of the means by which the Military Voter receives the ballot, the original ballot itself must be returned by mail or hand delivery to the District Clerk no later than 5:00 p.m. on Election Day.

If a military voter designates a preference for facsimile transmission or electronic mail but does not provide the necessary facsimile number or e-mail address, the board of education shall transmit the voter registration application, military ballot application or military ballot by mail and request the omitted information.

\*A "Military Voter" is "a qualified voter of the state of New York who is in actual military service, as defined above, and by reason of such military service is absent from his or her district on the day of
